Canada is part of the US

- **“Canada acceding to this confederation, and adjoining in the measures of the United States, shall be admitted into, and entitled to all the advantages of this Union; but no other colony shall be admitted into the same, unless such admission be agreed to by nine States.” Article 11, Articles of Confederation, 9 July, 1778**

Canada in 1778

- In 1778 Canada did not exist
- There was a colony called Upper Canada which is now called Ontario
- There was a colony called Lower Canada which is now called Quebec
- Canada did not exist until 1867 when the British North America Bill was pass by the Parliament of England

Articles of Confederation

- **“Chapter I. – An Act to extend the laws of the United States over the State of Texas, and for other purposes.”**, which was Approved on Dec. 29, 1845, by the Twenty-Ninth Congress, Session I, at 9 Stat. 1, where it says;
- ***“Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That all of the laws of the United States are hereby declared to extend to and over, and to have full force and effect within, the State of Texas, admitted at the present session of Congress into the Confederacy and Union of the United States.”***, [emphasis added],

Canada is part of the United States

- **“In this subtitle: (5) "State" has the meaning assigned by Section 311.005, Government Code, and includes a province of Canada.”** Sec. 541.002. Governmental Authorities. Texas Government Code
- **“The following definitions apply unless the statute or context in which the word or phrase is used requires a different definition: (7) "State," when referring to a part of the United States, includes any state, district, commonwealth, territory, and insular possession of the United States and any area subject to the legislative authority of the United States of America.”** Sec. 311.005. General Definitions. Texas Government Code

Canada - SEC

- **“The term “separate account” means an account established and maintained by an insurance company pursuant to the laws of any state or territory of the United States, the District of Columbia, or of Canada or any province of thereof...” Securities Act of 1933, which was Approved May 27, 1933 at 48 Stat 74**

- US District Court for the District of China
- “Chapter 128. - An Act to Provide for the Civil Code of the Canal Zone and to repeal the existing civil code” by the 72d Congress, Session II, which was Approved on February 27, 1933 at 47 Stat. 1346
- “SEC. 1732. REPEAL OF EXISTING LAWS.-The following codes, laws, executive orders, and parts thereof, are hereby repealed
- The Civil Code of the Republic of Panama and Amendatory Laws, the Commercial Code of the Republic of Panama, and all other laws, not heretofore repealed which were continued in force in the Canal Zone by the Executive order of May 9, 1904 ;”

American Empire

- **“Sec. 2. When used in this title, unless the context otherwise requires - (6) The term "Territory" means Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, the Philippine Islands, Canal Zone, the Virgin Islands, and the insular possessions of the United States.”** Securities Act of 1933 which was Approved on May 27, 1933 by the 73d Congress, Session I, at Chapter 38, at 48 Stat. 75
